Practice Problems:

Convert the temperature to Celsius

333 K Answer: 333 - 273 = 60 °C

173 K *Answer:* 173 - 273 = -100  $^{\circ}$ C

Convert the temperature to Kelvin

 $100^{0}$ C Answer:  $100^{0}$ C + 273 = 373 K

 $376^{\circ}$ C Answer:  $376^{\circ}$ C + 273 = 649 K
